Two of the Oakville Edge Synchronized Skating teams, representing the Oakville Skating Club, had an outstanding weekend at the Six-O Synchro Skate Competition in Whitby, Ont. this past weekend.

This was the first ever competition for Beginner synchro teams in Ontario. The Edge team responded confidently, demonstrating their newly developed skills and earning a Gold medal. The team placed 1st with an overall score of 18.87.

Skating to the Supremes, this team has worked extremely hard both on and off the ice. They are excited to be the first ever gold medalists in the newest category in synchronized skating.
